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New Delhi: Karnataka's JSS Academy of Higher Education and Research has broken into the top 100 in clinical and health studies of the Times Higher Education 'World University Rankings by Subject-2022'. THE rankings of 1,523 universities in 86 countries support the quality of education provided in clinical and health, life sciences, physical sciences and psy-

Globally, institutions in US, UK, Switzerland, Germany continued their dominance while Mainland China, Japan, Hong Kong and Australia surged up the tables. Unranked last year, JSS Academy bagged the 93rd position in the latest rankings. BIU, which is ranked in the 251-300 group, also improved its ranking. The other Indian university in the top 400 in a pool of 925 institutions is Manipal Academy of High-

US have claimed four places each, with the UK's University of Oxford retaining top spot for the eleventh consecutive year and Harvard University in the US holding onto second place. While IISc moved from top 300 to top 200 in life sciences, the other Indian institution making big gains is Birla Institute of Technology and Science, Pilani, which moved from top 600 to top 300. The US and UK are home to all of the world's top 10 universities for life sciences from a table of 972 institutions, as Harvard University claims top spot for the second consecutive year. 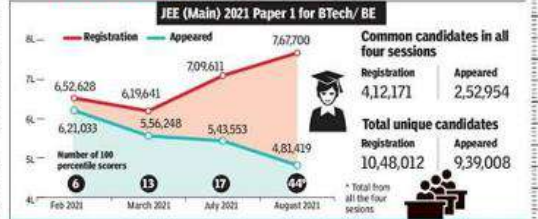

JEE (Advanced) sees 3-year-low cut-off marks across categories

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New Delhi: The qualifying marks to be eligible for JEE (Advanced), the entrance test for admission to IITs, has registered a three-year-low across all categories, according to the cut-offs announced by the National Testing Agency (NTA). A total of 2.5 lakh candidates from JEE (Main) have qualified for the JEE (Advanced). The qualifying percentile for unreserved category is 87.9 this year as against 89.7 in 2019, while for the OBC, it is 68 as against 74.3 in 2019. The cut-off for the EWS category came down from 78.2 in 2019 to 66.2 this year. The qualifying cut-off for SC and ST too fell substantially to 46.8 and 34.7 respectively as against 54 and 44.3 in 2019.

The registration for the JEE (Advanced) started on Wednesday and the exams are scheduled for October 3. For the first time in the last three years, the number of registrations crossed the 10-lakh mark with 10.5 lakh candidates registering of whom 8.4 lakh took the JEE (Main) which was conducted in four cycles for the first time this year. Over 4.1 lakh candidates registered for all the four cycles and 2.5 lakh appeared in all the four JEE (Mains) — February, March, July and August-September. Of the 44 candidates who scored 100 percentile, only 72.5 and 62.8 percentile in the first two attempts before scoring 100 percentile in the third attempt. Harshel Santosh Swain from Odisha scored 23.5, 11 and 23.7 in the first three attempts before scoring 99.9 percentile. In all, 250 candidates, who are in the 99 and above percentile bracket, improved their scores by taking the test multiple times with majority of them appearing taking all the four attempts.
