Thank you for visiting "[bob World hAAckathon](#)" contest website. Kindly read these terms and conditions carefully before you register for participation in "[bob World hAAckathon](#)" contest. By registering, you indicate that you accept the below terms and conditions.

- Candidates are advised to register with active e-mail ID for receiving communication pertaining to the Hackathon. Any information can be communicated be sent by the bobworldhackathon@bankofbaroda.com or directly by Bank of Baroda.
- Any individual citizen of India who is above 18 years of age can participate in only 1 team (either as part of a group or as an individual).
- By participating in the event, the individual(s) agree to be bound by the applicable Terms & Conditions and represent that they satisfy all the eligibility requirements that have been set out.
- The final version of documents / data as per cut-off dates of Phase 1 & Phase 2 will be treated as final submission from the participating individual / team. The final submission cannot be changed at a later juncture. Any such request received from any participant / team will not be entertained.
- Any employee of Bank of Baroda or M/s Pirimid or M/s Devfolio or any other partner linked to the hackathon technology partner/s will not be allowed to participate in this event.
- The Bank takes no responsibility for any delay in receipt or loss of any communication.
- Decisions of Bank of Baroda in all matters regarding eligibility, evaluation and selection would be final and binding on all the participants. No representation or correspondence will be entertained by the bank in this regard.
- Participation in the event is purely voluntary, and at the sole discretion of the individual(s) participating in the event. Bank of Baroda takes no responsibility for any cost incurred by the participants during the course of the event or for the event.

- **Hackathon Rules:**
 - a) The age limit: 18 years and above.
 - b) The age related proof / undertaking shall be submitted while registration.
 - c) For eligibility related criteria and other hackathon related details visit our bank's Website <https://www.bankofbaroda.in>.
 - d) The Hackathon is to be organized in 2 phase:
 - a. Phase 1 - Idea Submission Phase
 - b. Phase 2 - Prototype Phase
 - e) Participants are required to register first, as a team on the <https://bobworld-hackathon.devfolio.co/> website.
 - f) Team size can be from 1 (min.) up to of 4 (max.) members.
 - g) Participating individual / group can register for only one theme
 - h) Any individual can participate in only 1 team or at an individual level only. Any deviation will lead to disqualification of all teams that the individual participates in.
 - i) You cannot add/delete team members after the idea submission round ends.
 - j) It's an online Hackathon, you can participate from anywhere in India only.
 - k) Once the application is submitted, bank team would review the Idea description submitted and approve the application for participation in next rounds.
 - l) Once the Hackathon starts, you will get an option to submit your hack. You can submit as many times as you want, the last hack will be considered as the final submission.
 - m) The document size which shall be eligible for upload as part of Phase 1 is 5 MB.
 - n) The idea document shall be a pdf file and shall be constituting below sections,
 - ✓ Participant's name(s)
 - ✓ Idea title
 - ✓ Idea description
 - ✓ Process / System architecture
 - ✓ Technology adopted (OS, DB etc.)
 - ✓ Security parameters adopted (Hashing /Encryption etc.)
 - ✓ Benefits to Bank
 - ✓ Estimated duration for full-fledged implementation
 - o) After evaluation of Phase 1 Idea, selected teams will be invited to continue their participation for Phase 2 Prototype development.
 - p) Teams need to mention all the APIs you will be using while submitting your idea.
 - q) Teams may use any leading technologies for development of the concept. You may use open source libraries and other freely available systems. An undertaking in this regard would be obtained from the team.
 - r) Teams, however, are free to use APIs that have been developed by themselves.
 - s) Teams shortlisted for Phase 2 will be required to submit, the details of the sandbox environment would be shared with the qualifying individual/ team separately:
 - a. Developed Prototype
 - b. Demonstration Video
 - c. Sample Data that was presented in the Video
 - d. Documentation
 - t) Top 10 Teams will be called to present a live demonstration before the evaluation



committee in Mumbai.

- u) The intellectual property of your code belongs only to you or your team. On further commercial relationship with bank, the intellectual property right would be transferred to Bank, post execution of mutual agreement.
- v) All teams are free to innovate and go beyond provided pointers. Participants are encouraged to explore more alternatives / enhance the idea for better implementation.
- w) The teams shall not demonstrate any existing solution or collaborate with companies that have existing solution. Such hacks will be disqualified. An undertaking towards the same will have to be provided by the team
- x) The Prototype designed/developed should not violate/breach/copy any copyrighted, patented or existing solution available in the market. Non-compliance, will lead to disqualification from the hackathon.
- y) Participants may get a potential opportunity to explore a commercial relationship with Bank.
