C. LOCATION OF POSTING : The candidate will be deployed as per requirement of the Bank, preferably in the state of Uttar Pradesh. However, they may be deputed to work in any other part of the country if and as deemed necessary.

D. <u>SELECTION PROCEDURE:</u>

Selection will be based on short listing and subsequent round of Personal Interview and/or Group Discussion.

- Bank reserves the right to change (cancel/ modify/ add) any of the criteria, method of selection and provisional allotment etc.

GUIDELINES FOR SCANNING THE PHOTOGRAPH (4.5cmX3.5cm) & SIGNATURE :

Before applying online, a candidate will be required to have a scanned (digital) image of his/ her photograph and signature as per the specifications given below:-

(i) <u>Photograph Image :-</u>

- > Photograph must be a recent passport style colour picture.
- > Make sure that the picture is in colour, taken against a light coloured, preferably white background.
- Look straight at the camera with a relaxed face.
- If the picture is taken on a sunny day, have the sun behind you, or place yourself in the shade, so that you are not squinting and there are no harsh shadows.
- If you have to use flash, ensure there's no "red-eye".
- > If you wear glasses make sure that there are no reflections and your eyes can be clearly seen.
- > Caps, hats and dark glasses are not acceptable, religious headwear is allowed but it must not cover your face.
- Dimensions 200 x 230 pixels (preferred)
